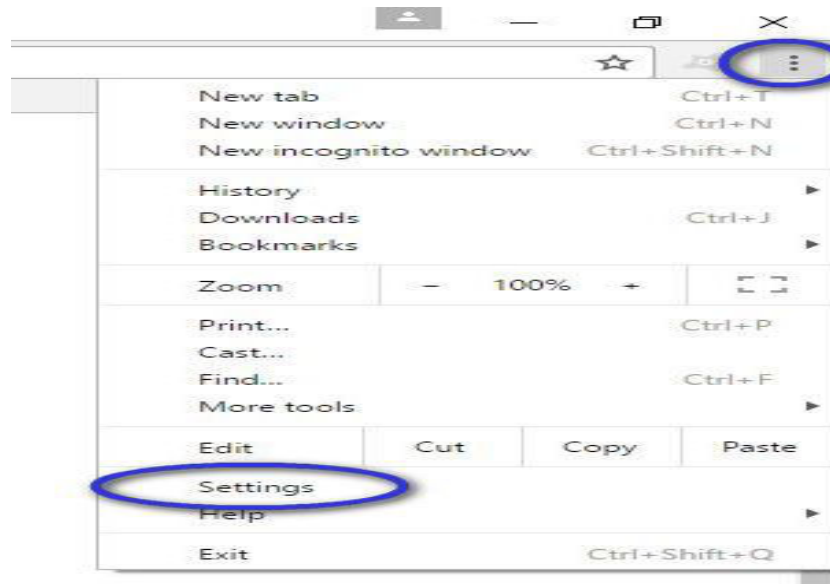
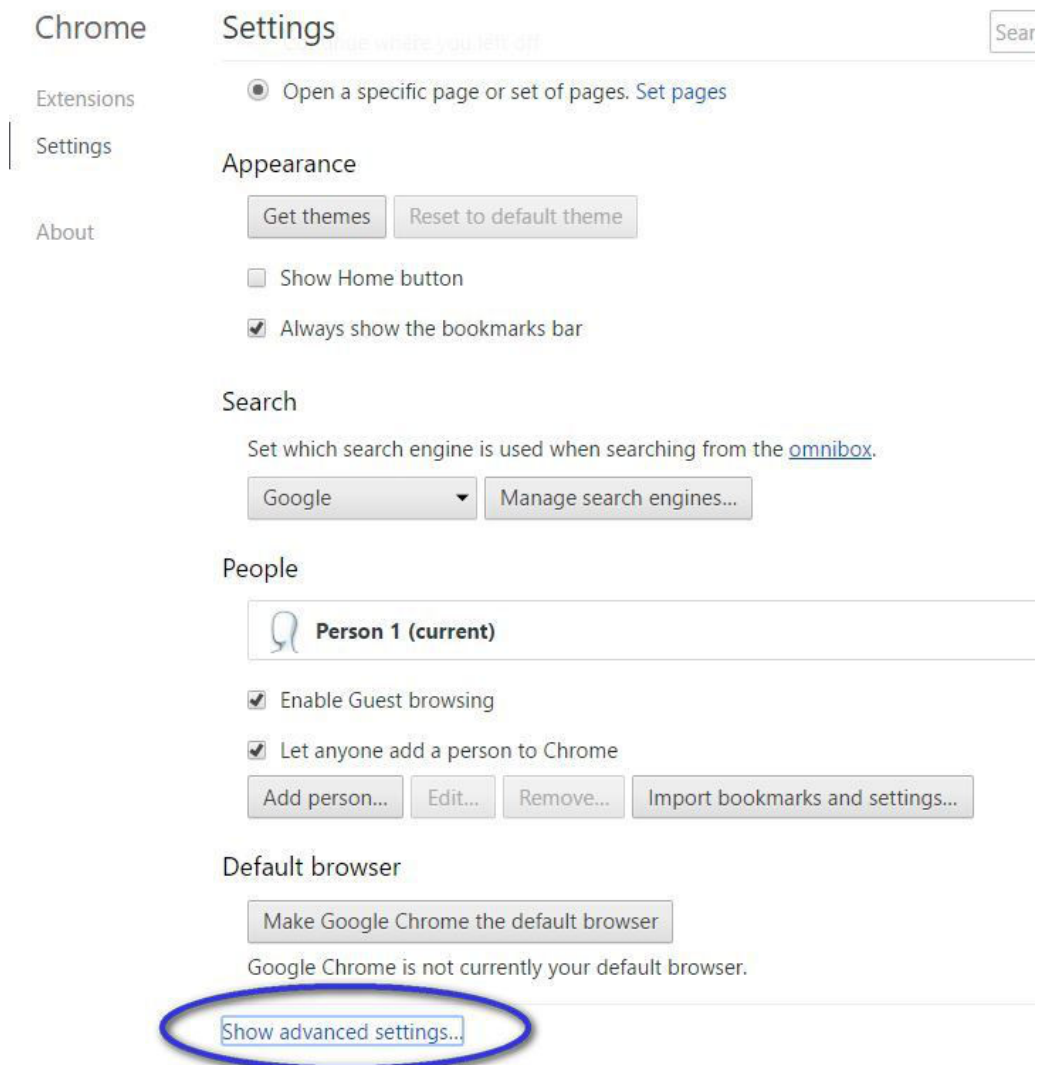


# Chrome Browser


1. Click the dots on the top right of your window and then select Settings.


